Members name and Club (or Clubs if a member of more than one Local Club) shall be put on the back of the mount. An entry fee of 3d per print will be paid. Entered prints must be handed to Club secretary by Dec. 30th, as they are going to Mr. C.C. Davis of Bath for judging, and who will visit Bridge St. on Jan. 15th. Prizes will be presented for prints judged 1st and 2nd, and other awards of merit will also be made.

Should there be an excessive entry, the Competing Clubs Committees reserve the right to select the requisite number to go forward.
